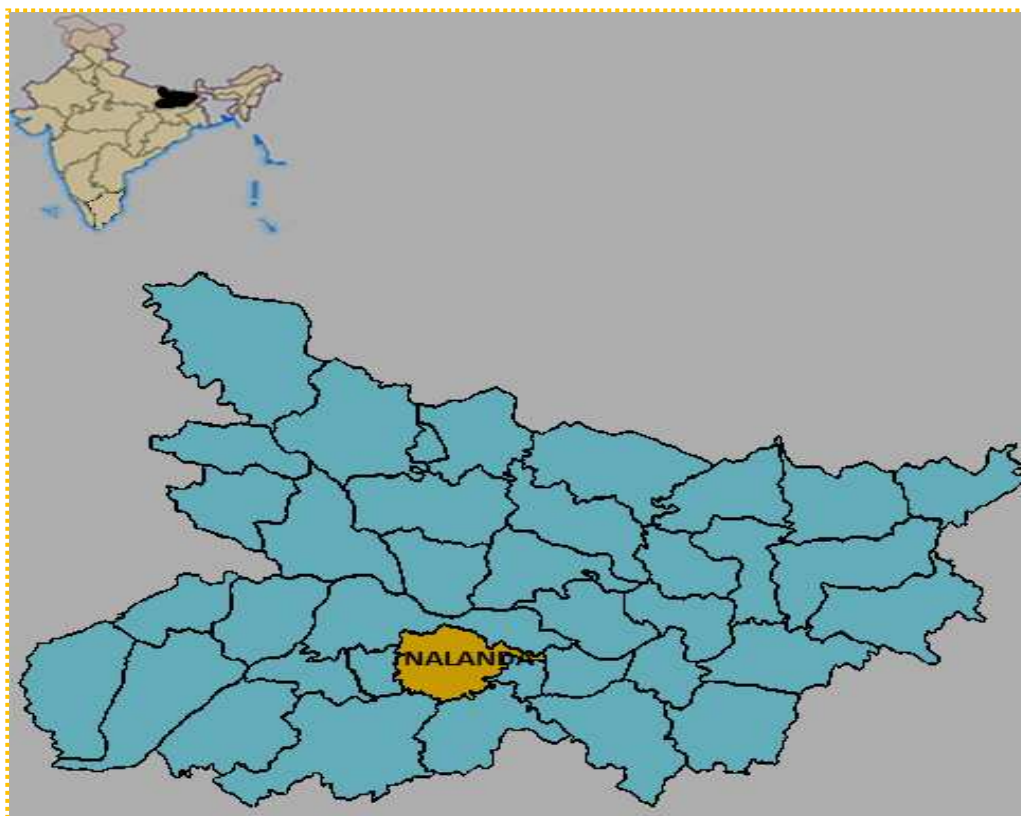

PROGRESS DURING THE PERIOD

■ **ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS PROGRAM**

Awareness shapes a hierarchy of values, and at the same time has an influence on the sense of responsibility for inappropriate choice of values and indifference towards wrongdoing. Public awareness of the environment means the ability to emotionally understand the surrounding world, including the laws of the natural environment, sensitivity to all the changes occurring in the environment, understanding of cause-and-

effect relationships between the quality of the environment and human behaviour, an understanding of how the environment works as a system, and a sense of responsibility for the common heritage of the Earth, such as natural resources - with the aim of preserving them for future generations.

To know and understand what is good and what is better, and at the same time commit a wrongdoing, is socially more injurious than committing a wrongdoing in ignorance. Therefore, to reduce this ignorance among the masses, environment awareness camps were organized in 5 villages of the Giriyak block that resulted in reaching to the common masses on the importance of the protection, preservation, management or restoration of wildlife and natural resources such as forests and water. Through the conservation of biodiversity, the survival of many species and habitats which are threatened due to human activities can be ensured.



A total of **162** people that included local NGOs, teachers, youth groups, school children, PRIs and general people of the area were reached by these camps. A child rally was also organized that promoted a positive thinking among the people on environment and its protection.

■ **MNREGA AWARENESS MEETING**

Supported by NACDOR, New Delhi an awareness meeting was organized with **50** MNREGA workers. The message was put across in various ways, including through wall writings, street plays and posters. During the camp, special emphasis was put to raise awareness on dissemination of right based provisions of the act to ensure that the workers must know their right to demand wage employment and exercise their right by applying for such employment as per their need. Beyond raising awareness, interventions at interpersonal level also provided to ensure that individuals may convert this awareness into action.



■ **NUTRITION AWARENESS PROGRAM**

DJKS operates with the commitment to health for all. In 2015-16, health camps at regular intervals were organized for providing health solutions to women in rural areas. A "Nutrition Awareness Camp" was organized by DJKS on 27.06.2015 at village Surumpur in Silao block through which **42** pregnant women benefitted.

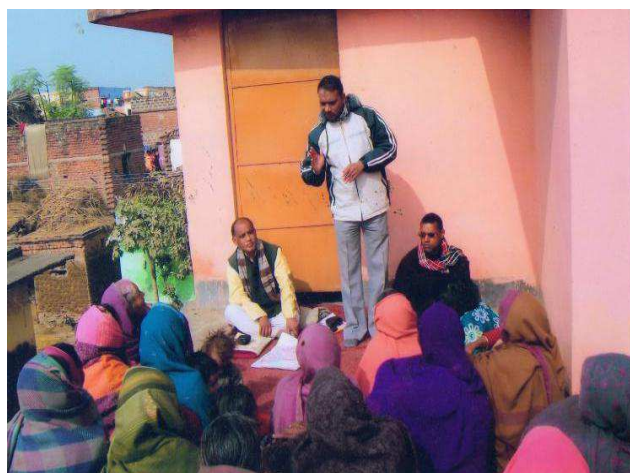
The camp generated awareness among the pregnant women for precautions to be taken during the pregnancy period and why it is important to maintain appropriate hygiene practices during the period. The program was a success and the pregnant women were highly benefited through it.



■ **VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM**

In 2015-16, DJKS imparted 3 months vocational training course from 1.01.16 to 31.03.16 to **30** poor and needy women in “Sewing and Cutting” trade in Pawapuri block in Nalanda district in Bihar. The women learnt the sewing and cutting skills sincerely that is now helping them to improve their poor income. In the training program, preference was given to “Dalit” women. As an integral part of the program, beneficiaries were also imparted entrepreneurship development training and they have now opted for self-employment/employment after training.

A 3 months (3.08.2015 to 03.10.2015) Computer training course was conducted for **18** school children of the Mahadalit community in Pawapuri. The training helped children to become familiar with computer & basics of information technology, so that they can find their place in coming stages where IT plays a major role in their education.



■ **DALIT DIGNITY AWARENESS PROGRAM**

Dalit community across South Asia, irrespective of their faith, continues to suffer several social disabilities arising out of the acute caste discrimination which is still rampant in many parts of the sub-continent. In addition to discrimination against Dalit which is laid bare in all spheres of life, severe forms of abuse and violence are inflicted on them daily. DJKS is strives to eliminate caste discrimination that change to bring full dignity and

equality to Dalit in Nalanda district in Bihar. Following activities were undertaken in 2015-16 for promoting the cause by DJKS:

a. **Dalit Dignity & Awareness Program**: An awareness program was organized in April, 2015 for promoting the rights and entitlements of Dalits. 4 villages/tolas- Pawadih, Dhamar, Chandi Mao and Bakshu of the Pawadih Panchayat in Silao block in Nalanda district were covered under the program. Periodic awareness programs in the forms of camps and meetings were organized with Dalits men and women to sensitize them on the 'social inclusion', 'empowerment' and 'right based' approaches, SC/ST Prevention of Atrocities Act 1989, Domestic Violence Act, filing of RTIs and how to get access to the government schemes and programs. On the occasion, awareness was also promoted about the life and works of Baba Saheb Bhim Rao Ambedkar and told the participants to emulate his teachings in their life. A total of 75 Dalit men and women were benefitted by the program.



c. **Dalit Adhikar Yatra**: To mobilize Dalits about their rights and entitlements, a "Dalit Adhikar Yatra" was launched on the occasion of "Labour Day" on 1/05/2015 by DJKS from village Nanand to village Dhamar covering a distance of almost 2 km in Silao block. It was a huge crowd gathered during the Yatra and men, women, youth and children of the Dalit community actively participated in it. Through this yatra, the Dalit gave a strong message to the society about their rights and entitlements.

d. **Literacy Program**: The literacy rate among the SC/Dalits in Bihar has been dismally low at a mere 28.5 percent during the 2001 census, which is nearly half of that recorded for all SC population at the national level (54.7%). The male and female literacy rates are 40.2 percent and 15.6 percent respectively against the corresponding national figures of 66.6 percent and 41.9 percent. Among the literates, 39.7 percent of the SC are either without any educational level or have attained education below primary level.



In Nalanda district the SC/Dalit literacy percentage is dismally low. For giving it a boost in 2015-16, DJKS organized a literacy program in the month of June, 2015 for Dalits in village Surumpur in Ghostawan Panchayat in Silao block through which 55 men and women were reached.

■ **WORKSHOPS & CAMPS**

DJKS believes that information dissemination is important for the development of the human being and society. In 2015-16, workshops and camps were organized on different relevant topics in our all operational blocks in Nalanda district periodically. A good number of participants that involved MNREGA workers, Men, Women and

Disabled were benefitted by the program. Experienced resource persons and eminent personalities shared their knowledge and views with the participants and made the program a success. The details are as follows-

■ **WOMEN RIGHTS/ADHIKAR PROGRAM**

DJKS organized an awareness program on the occasion of International Women’s Day on 08/03/2016 at Pawapuri in Giriyak block in which **45** women participated. The awareness program provided right awareness among the participants on advancing women’s rights, equality and participation in the decision making process.

During the program, women shared their experiences and expressed collective declaration for their rights and dignity.



■ ***DISABLED WELFARE PROGRAM***

Helping the disabled persons to fully participate in social life is one of the important programs of DJKS. Plights of disabled people are found to be worst in Silao and Giriyak, blocks of Nalanda district in Bihar.

In 2015-16, household surveys were done by DJKS in Pawapuri in Giriyak block in which a total of **26** physical disabled were identified. One awareness camp was also organized in which the disabled were informed about the govt. schemes and programs. Disabled were also helped by DJKS for getting disability certificates for their long term benefits.
